### **Public Sector Young Professional of the Year**

To acknowledge and celebrate the contributions of a public sector professional under 35 years of age

### **Contribution to Community**

To acknowledge and celebrate individuals or teams delivering programs or projects that are making valuable contributions to the Tasmanian community

Nominations are open from Monday 30 September 2019 to Friday 15 November 2019. Winners will be announced at the IPAA Tasmania State of the Service event in December.

## **Public Sector Excellence Awards 2019**

Nominations will be considered by a sub-committee of the IPAA Council and will consider, the nominee's:

- contribution to the public sector community and to building a culture of excellence in public sector practice;
- approach and commitment to professionalism and integrity in the public sector; and
- delivery of programs, services and outcomes as part of an inclusive public sector community.

The recommendations of the sub-committee will be confirmed by the IPAA Tasmania President and Council, and are final.
